THE 'HARVESTS' & HOLODOMOR MEMORY & SCHOLARSHIP

An examination of the role of the Ukrainian diaspora in North America in raising awareness of the Holodomor, especially through the sponsorship of two pivotal works: the documentary film *Harvest of Despair* and the book *The Harvest of Sorrow*. Additionally, the Cold War political climate influenced the reception of these works is analysed. The main conclusion highlights the significance of these 'Harvests' and the commitment of the Ukrainian diaspora communities in North America to bring them to fruition.

THROUGH A MIRROR DARKLY: SELF-REFLECTIONS IN POLISH HOLOCAUST CINEMA

An exploration of the ways in which Poles have presented themselves within Holocaust Cinema produced within the national borders of Poland to a specific Polish audience during the Socialist Era. Examining three eras of Polish Cinema: The Film Polski Era, The Polish Film School Era, and the Period of Moral Anxiety, and three representative films, this paper aims to shed light on the evolving Polish perspective of the Holocaust, specifically focusing on the developing image of Polish self-identification as witness within Holocaust cinema.

INFORMATION, PROPAGANDA, AND AKTION 1005

An analysis of German efforts to suppress information concerning atrocities committed in occupied territories as well as evidence of the extermination of the Jews. The essay examines how Nazi leadership took advantage of contemporary views of atrocity stories to misinform, the Katyń Forest Massacre propaganda campaign to distract, and the *Aktion 1005* units efforts to destroy evidence of mass crimes to interrupt and silence communication of the truth being proclaimed to the world.

APPROACHING ATROCITY PROPAGANDA: A HISTORIOGRAPHICAL APPROACH

An essay that attempts to provide a historiography of atrocity propaganda from the earliest theoretical studies of the genre of propaganda to the most recent understandings of within the context of A. Dirk Moses' Language of Transgression.

STORIES FROM THE THIRD FLOOR

Book Project. Part historical connect the dots and part personal narrative, *Stories from the Third Floor* will be the book component of the documentary film project *Into the Field of Ashes*.
